PWB Broadband Funding Since 2019

What has been done so far?

- \$450K to nine broadband planningfeasibility study grants
- \$58M to 23 broadband construction projects
- \$12M to three county government broadband construction projects

Once complete, construction projects will add **590 miles** of fiber and provide for **10,582** connections.

- Attend webinar and join our mailing list
- Review scoring criteria (posted 60-days prior)
- Engage early and often with community stakeholders, and ISPs





Program Requirements

PWB Unique Requirements	
Unserved	Lack access to at least 100/20
Project Speed Goals	Meets or exceeds state goals (RCW 43.330.536)
Hardship Methodology and Affordability	 Funding limits: \$5m maximum, up to 90% of total project cost for distressed and severely distressed for rural counties and/or Indian Country Low interest rate loan funding 2-year Loan deferral
Provider Notification	Prior to submitting pre-application area providers must be notified and provider response must be submitted in pre-application
Objection/Challenge Process	30-days following pre-application process area service provider may object to proposed project
Public Use Policy	IRU may be required to ensure public use for 15 years
