

Glossary of Terms

EUI

Energy Use Intensity – The annual amount of all the energy your property consumes on-site, regardless of source, divided by property square footage.

wnEUI

Weather Normalized Energy Use Intensity - The energy use per square foot your property would have consumed during 30-year average weather conditions.

EUIt

Energy Use Intensity Target – The energy use per square foot target set by the Washington State Clean Building Act, according to building type.





Glossary of Terms

Portal

Reporting and management system for both tiers.

Energy Management Plan

Living document that is updated annually.

Operations and Maintenance Plan

Living document that shows how existing equipment and systems are maintained.

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


The Four Three Compliance Pathways

Timeline for Demonstrating 12 Months of Compliance





Compliance Timeline

Tier 1 Compliance Dates

June 1, 2026

Greater than 220,000 sq. ft.

June 1, 2027

- Greater than 90,000 sq. ft. but less than 220,001 sq. ft.

June 1, 2028

- Greater than 50,000 sq. ft. but less than 90,001 sq. ft.

Tier 2 Compliance Dates

July 1, 2027

- Greater than 20,000 sq. ft. but less than 50,001 sq. ft.
- Includes all multifamily greater than 20,000 sq. ft.


